RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF and/or WDAA RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
2. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final.
3. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.
4. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges.
5. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees.
6. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation.
7. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.
8. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform.
9. It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable presented to appear before an audience.
10. **ENTRY PROCEDURE:** Entries must be made on an official entry form or photocopy of same and must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, all signatures, (no dittos), organization membership numbers and fees. Riders participating in this schooling show are NOT required to hold memberships with any organization. However, for scores to count in WDAA classes, the rider and horse must fulfill WDAA membership requirements. It is the responsibility of the competitor to contact WDAA to determine those requirements. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first served basis until classes are filled. **Class fees are \$25 per class for PBEA members, \$30 for non-members.** A non-refundable Office Fee of \$20 per horse per day applies to each entry. Entries received after the closing date will be accepted only if the schedule permits. Each late entry that has been accepted shall be assessed a late fee of \$50. Changes to entries after the closing date will be at the sole discretion of the show management with a \$25 change fee. No telephone or faxed entries will be accepted. Complete entry with check must be RECEIVED by closing date. **Payment in full or an open check must accompany the entry made payable to PBEA.**
11. **AMATEURS AND YOUTH:** Amateurs are defined by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book. All riders entering the Amateur classes must qualify under USEF Amateur criteria prior to riding in the class. Individuals are eligible as Youth until the end of the calendar year in which they will be 18 years of age.
12. **STABLING:** Stabling fees are \$20 a stall per night. Bedding will be available at the Show Office or bring your own. Tack stalls are free but please specify that you need one so we can assign. Stalls have no electric. They are about ¼ mile from Equestrian Park, within easy riding distance, or you can haul and park on the grass.
13. **REFUNDS:** All cancellations/scratches must be made in writing via email to the show Secretary. All fees, less a \$20 office fee, will be returned if horses are scratched before the Closing Date. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS OF CLASS FEES FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.**
14. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** A negative Coggins test must be provided for every horse participating in this competition. Out of state horses must also have a current (within 30 days) Veterinary Health Inspection. Stabling will not be assigned until this documentation is provided to the Secretary.
15. **RIDE TIMES:** Will be available on the PBEA website (www.powderbasinequestrian.com) by Tuesday, August 25
16. **DIRECTIONS TO CAMPLEX EQUESTRIAN PARK:** Corner of Fox Park Road and E Boxelder Drive. Stabling at CAM- PLEX Facility, directly west of Equestrian Park. No hook-ups available this weekend! Dry camping is free.
